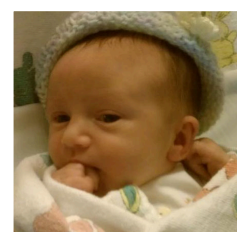
W.: CHRIS HODAPP'S MEMBORABLE VISIT
