"The words "worship" and "worshipful" as used in Freemasonry have no connection with their modern meaning of glorification, idolization, deification.... the words being used in the old English sense... Masonic usage of the word may be freely given as respected, or honored. The Most Worshipful Brother is he who is most greatly honored or respected. This is doubtless as much a descendant from ecclesiastical practice as from old English phraseology; an Episcopal marriage service used "with my body I thee worship" meaning honor or reverence. "
