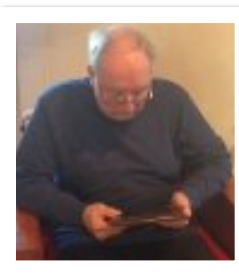

MASONIC HISTORY

The "Enabling Act" was passed by Germany's parliament (the Reichstag) on March 23, 1933. Using the "Act", on January 8, 1934 the German Ministry of the Interior ordered the disbandment of Freemasonry, and confiscation of the property of all Lodges.

In 1934, the German Grand Lodge of the Sun in Bayreuth (one of the pre-war German Grand Lodges), realized the imminent problems facing them and elected that a little blue flower, the Forget-Me-Not, in lieu of the traditional Square and Compasses, be a mark of identity for Masons.

The number of Freemasons from Nazi occupied countries who were killed is not accurately known, but it is estimated that between 80,000 and 200,000 Freemasons were murdered under the Nazi regime.

AYL MASONIC SPEAKER SERIES

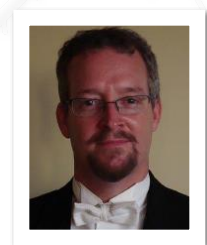
