On Tuesday, September 27, Bro. Peter Bouchard was Passed to the degree of Fellow Craft at the Pelham Masonic Temple, home to Pulpit Rock Lodge No. 103. Our Brother received a wonderful degree led by our Senior Warden, Bro. Ryan Flynn as Master. After which, we listened to a fantastic lecture by Bro. Matthew 'Doc' Perry, Director of the Museum at Fort Adams, Newport, R.I., who offered evidence associated with early 15th century settlement of the Narragansett Bay, rune stones and the Newport Tower.
