Information on Proposed By-Laws Change

At the Stated Communication on October 14, 2014, the following changes, as previously proposed, will be voted on by the Brethren present.

CURRENT Bylaw

Section 2. The fees for membership by affiliation or dual membership shall be Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00), plus the annual Lodge dues set at the Stated Communication in September of the preceding year, in addition to any Grand Lodge fee, which shall accompany the petition.

Bylaw as AMENDED

Section 2. The fees for membership by affiliation or dual membership shall be Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00), plus an apportioned amount of the annual Lodge dues, in addition to any Grand Lodge fee, which shall accompany the petition. The apportioned amount of the dues shall be one-twelfth of the annual dues set at the Stated Communication in September of the preceding year for each full month remaining in the calendar year, rounded up to the nearest dollar.

AYL Night of Masonic Light
