2021 Dues Recommendation from the Finance Committee

The Finance Committee consisting of the Master, Wardens, Treasurer and Secretary has recommended an increase of dues for 2021. The amounts would fall as follows: \$200 for Dues (\$145 Lodge, \$45 Grand Lodge Per Capita, \$10 Masonic Building Association Assessment). This represents a \$19 per year increase or \$1.58 per month. Among the several considerations driving the increase, the rent that our Lodge pays will be increasing in 2021. Our petition fee will remain unchanged at \$225. A vote on this will take place at the September Stated Communication.
